Isolated in the North Atlantic Ocean, the Faroe Islands need to be self-sufficient in terms of electricity generation as the Faroese electrical grid is not interconnected to neighbouring countries. Can the Faroe Islands convert their energy system to renewable sources?

A number of researchers have studied the conversion of the Faroe Islands' energy system to renewable sources. These studies looked at a single island or more broadly [51, 53] and their primary focus was on the techno-economic optimization of the new system.

How much solar irradiation will the Faroe Islands produce in 2021?

At the same time, the plant is the first major photovoltaic system in the Faroe Islands, and although we are only in mid-November and solar irradiation in 2021 is more than 10% below normal levels, with 161,200 kWh it has already produced more than the estimated nominal production.

What are the key innovations in energy planning for the Faroe Islands?
