



# Angola 10 mw solar power plant cost

How much solar energy does Angola have?

**SOLAR ENERGY:** 100 MW UNTIL 2025 Angola has a high solar resource potential, with an annual average global horizontal radiation between 1.350 and 2.070 kWh/m<sup>2</sup>/year. Solar energy constitutes the largest and more uniformly distributed renewable resource of the country.

How much does a solar plant cost in Angola?

Located in Lubango, the capital of Angola's Huíla Province, commercial operations of the 35 MW solar plant are expected by the end of 2023. The three stakeholders are uniting to finance, construct and operate the plant, which holds an estimated cost of \$82 million.

What are the major photovoltaic projects in Angola?

The Quilemba Solar Power Park is another major photovoltaic project underway in Angola, backed by PPP among France's Total Eren (51%), Angola's Sonangol (30%) and local renewable developer Greentech (19%). Located in Lubango, the capital of Angola's Huíla Province, commercial operations of the 35 MW solar plant are expected by the end of 2023.

What is the largest solar power plant in Angola?

With an installed capacity of 189 MW directed to over one million households, the Bié photovoltaic power plant represents the largest solar power project in Angola, made up of nearly 510,000 solar panels.

What makes Angola a good country for solar power?

Abundant sunshine, high solar radiation levels and a low electrification rate make Angola conducive to the development of solar photovoltaic power. The country's first solar power plants - located in Bié and Bacia Farta - were inaugurated in July 2022 and will supply electricity to 1.5 million households.

Who will build a 50 MW solar power plant in Angola?

The Italian company ENI signed a concession agreement with the government for the construction of a 50 MW solar plant in Namibe province, in southwestern Angola. The solar power plant will be constructed by Solenova, a joint venture between ENI and Angolan state-owned oil producer Sonangol.

The Quilemba Solar Power Station is a planned 35 MW (47,000 hp) solar power plant in Angola. The power station is in the development stage, by a consortium comprising Total Eren, a subsidiary of TotalEnergies, the French oil conglomerate, in collaboration with Greentech-Angola Environment Technology and Sonangol, the Angolan energy parastatal. It is a three-phase mission that aims to install 20,000 MW on-grid solar power plants, 2000 MW off-grid solar power plant including 20 million solar lights, and to create favorable conditions for developing solar manufacturing capability in the country.

Earlier this year, the consortium of Sun Africa, MCA Solar Angola and Hitachi ABB Power Grids broke ground on 370 MW of solar PV projects in Angola. These are split across seven different facilities now under-construction, including the 188.88 MWdc Biopioa solar plant and the 96.70 MWdc Benguela solar plant. These are developed under a \$650m integrated ...

Set in Lubango, Huila Province, the plant will operate under a fixed-price power purchase agreement, marking TotalEnergies' first solar investment in Angola. This project follows the Caraculo solar plant, which was launched in May 2023 as a public-private partnership with Eni and has a capacity of 25 MW.

The project is part of a planned seven solar power plants with a capacity of 370 MW to be built in seven provinces of Angola. Constructed at an estimated investment of EUR 38.8 million (USD 41.8m), the Saurimo solar power plant consists of 44,850 solar panels, and produces enough power to meet the needs of 171,000 people.
