



# Are rooftop solar panels illegal

A rooftop solar system puts solar panels on your roof to make electricity. It includes solar panels, an inverter, and a monitoring system. This is how many solar panels you can put on this roof: If you only use 100-watt solar panels, you can put 103 100-watt solar panels on the roof.
