More than 70 per cent of that comes from renewable sources, the rest from nuclear power. The government's target is 100 per cent fossil-free electricity production ...

The point is to move away from fossil energy sources and scale up renewable energy sources. Austria has been quite successful. On the Energy Transition Index ETI), Austria was able to move up two places from last year and now ranks sixth in the list of 115 surveyed countries. Only Denmark, Finland, Norway, Switzerland and Sweden did better.
