Sint Eustatius and Saba are located south of Sint Maarten and northwest of Saint Kitts and Nevis. The three islands gained their current status following the dissolution of the Netherlands Antilles on 10 October 2010, while at the same time the islands of Curaçao and Sint Maarten became autonomous countries within the Kingdom of the Netherlands.

The Kingdom Representative for the public bodies Bonaire, St Eustatius and Saba serves as the link between Dutch central government in The Hague and the 3 public bodies in the Caribbean Netherlands. The office of the Kingdom Representative is located on Bonaire.

Despite being grouped together as the Caribbean Netherlands, the island of Bonaire is in fact just over 800 kilometers away from the other islands of Eustatius and Saba. Bonaire is just off the coast of Venezuela, while Saba and Eustatius are just to the east of Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands. Yet all of them feature true natural beauty.

The maritime administration transferred to the Minister of Infrastructure and the Environment (IenM) in the Netherlands.
