How khoumaguéli solar plant will benefit the National Grid?

The combination of hydro and solar energy will help in maximising delivery of renewable energy to the national grid. The Khoumaguéli Solar plant is expected to mitigate against the impact of fluctuating rainfall on hydro power generation at the Garafiri plant.

What is the first grid-connected solar PV array in Guinea?

The solar energy facility will be the first grid-connected solar photovoltaic (PV) array in Guinea. The project is being developed by InfraCo Africa with the support of Aldwych Africa Developments Ltd, in partnership with experienced French solar PV developer, Solvéo Energie S.A.S, a subsidiary of Solvéo Developpement.

What is khoumaguéli solar project?

It comes after a concession agreement was signed in February 2019. The Khoumaguéli solar project will complement the nearby 75-MW Garafiri hydroelectric plant to optimise renewable energy supply to the national grid. The solar facility is expected to reduce the impact of fluctuating rainfall on the Garafiri plant's generation.

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The German company is currently working on an 82 MW solar project in Guinea, one of the largest independent solar power production projects in the West African region. The project, spread over two sites, will bring clean and cost-effective energy to the port city of Kamsar via a mini-grid with 12 km of grid extension and to the city of Boké ...

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InfraCo Africa, part of the Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG) and Solveo Energie, have signed a 25-year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with Electricité de Guinée (EDG) for the development of the 40MWac Khoumaguéli Solar project. 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The solar park will be the first grid-connected PV facility in Guinea. It will be constructed near the city of Linsan, Kindia province, working in combination with a 75-MW hydropower facility so as to enable the plant to work at full capacity overnight.

The 40MWac Khoumagueli Solar project will be Guinea's first grid-connected solar photovoltaic plant and is designed to complement power generation at the nearby 75 MW Garafiri hydroelectric plant. The facilities will combine to maximise delivery of renewable energy to ...
