

Can I change clothes in the pool lockers

Changing stalls are small stalls where clothes can be changed in privacy. They are used for swimming purposes. Locker rooms are usually gender-specific spaces where clothes are changed and stored in lockers. They are often used for swimming or other sporting purposes.

In my experience at 24 Hour Fitness in 4 different states, members change at their locker outside of changing or showers, they stay covered. I will add that it is rude to track water into the locker area from the showers or pool.

Street shoes are sometimes dropped off somewhere before entering the pool area or locker room. Having slippers is helpful especially if the pool is outdoors and wintertime and the walking area is wet. Lockers could be located in the locker room or some places just have doorless boxes along the wall to stuff with your things and towel.

The room where you change clothes for sports/P.E. is known as the "changing room" (although people might understand you if you said "locker room", because of American TV shows). Dressing room is the name given to a room in the house dedicated to where you get dressed (they'll have wardrobes, mirrors, and perhaps a dressing table), but they're rare - only found in ...
