Can you use a plastic storage bin for a tortoise enclosure?

The largest plastic storage bins can be used to create temporary indoor tortoise enclosures. However, it is difficult to get the space needed without modifying the bins and connecting several together. Remember ventilation and microclimates are important. Do not use the included storage bin lids.

Can tortoises eat cardboard?

You can use cardboard, plywood or plastic boxes as containers for tortoises and turtles within the refrigerator. Obviously, cardboard and wood are unsuitable for any species that requires a moist substrate. For species that require a dry substrate, they are useable, however. Boxes should not be too small.

There are brackets (cups?) Sold at most hardware stores that allow you to cut and use a portion of a wooden broomstick handle or PVC pipe across the sides of a box enclosure. Allowing you to suspend a CHE and still use the lid of the box to access your tortoises with ease. Unfortunately, my photo doesn't show the brackets.

Overuse of live foods has done a lot of damage to captive turtles, and may be implicated in the deformities that are developing in captive turtles. Live foods are highly enticing to many box turtles, leading to picky eating habits and vitamin deficiencies. When a turtle can expect to be fed "candy," it won't go looking for healthier foods.

With a lifespan ranging from 80 to 150 years, a pet tortoise can be a lifelong commitment, so it's important to find an enclosure that keeps them safe and happy. Whether you've got a teeny Egyptian tortoise or a bulkier Leopard tortoise, the best enclosure will be one that can provide for their well-being over the long term.

Russian or Horsfield tortoises originate from harsh climates and are notorious for not settling into hibernation as quickly as other hibernating species. It is recommended that a box made from wood/plywood or a plastic storage box be used, with air holes, to ensure the tortoise does not claw through the sides. Being more resilient to lower

I use a plastic shoe box type thing to contain all my cords and thermostat and keep things a little neater, and to prevent the tortoises from getting tangled in the wires. I use coffee cup hanging hooks to route my wires and keep them out of tortoise reach. Use a medium or heavy duty extension cord. At least 14 gauge, if not 12.

The other consideration you have to make is that in many states it is illegal to have or take box turtles from the wild. Fines can be quite large. Housing the Common Box Turtle . Box turtles do best in a turtle-safe outdoor pen that mimics their natural environment, as long as temperatures don't fall below 50 degrees Fahrenheit. The pen should have walls that are at least 18 inches tall with an overhang to prevent the turtle from climbing out.

Or you can use a Mercury Vapor Bulb which produces UVA, heat, and UVB all in one bulb. NEVER use a coil or compact bulb as these can pose a serious danger to the turtle and can lead to blindness. Also, no colored or light producing bulbs at night. They need complete darkness at night to sleep properly.

Large plastic tubs, such as cement mixing trays, large storage containers, or stock ponds, can be used. Some people have also had success keeping turtles in large indoor pens constructed out of wood, often on top of a table or raised ...
