Attracting those with education, skills and resources to return is crucial for Syria's revival. "Syrians with money are key," said Dr. Landis at the University of Oklahoma, but many of them will not return if there is no electricity or rule of law. Syria's neighbors also have a keen interest in the return of refugees and in rebuilding.
