

What are the relations between Sudan and the European Union?

This page provides information about the relations between Sudan and the European Union. The relations between Sudan and the European Union (EU) began in 1975. The EU is represented in Sudan by a fully accredited diplomatic mission. The EU Delegation is located in the Sudanese capital of Khartoum and is headed by an EU Ambassador.

What does EU do in Sudan?

Development Cooperation is one of the main pillars of the EU presence in Sudan. In 2021, the EU has 85 ongoing projects and programmes in the country financed from the EU budget, European Development Fund (EDF) and EU Trust Fund (EUTF) for Africa for a value of approximately EUR 480 million.

How does the European Union support Sudan's transition?

This is a major step towards civilian-led rule with a historic opportunity to achieve peace, democracy and economic recovery. The European Union supports the consolidation of the Sudanese transition by accompanying the country on its path of political and economic reforms.

Why does the EU support the Sudanese people?

The people of Sudan deserve freedom, peace and justice, which they have been aspiring to since their Revolution began in 2019. The EU reaffirms its steadfast support and solidarity with the Sudanese people in view of a better future.

How much does the EU support Sudan?

Concretely, the European Commission has committed today EUR355 million in both humanitarian and development funding for Sudan and its neighbours. Together with the pledge from EU States of EUR541 million, total EU support to Sudan pledged at the conference amounts to EUR896 million.

How do EU bodies work together in Sudan?

EU bodies like EU Parliament (EP), European Commission (EC), European External Action Service (EEAS), and European Union Member States work together, hand in hand, in full cooperation and coordination to this end through a steady flow of high level and technical visits and through a wide range of programs in Sudan.

In 2020, the European Union provided EUR44.05 million in support of humanitarian action in South Sudan. Out of the total new EU aid package, EUR52 million is allocated in humanitarian assistance in Sudan to support the most vulnerable caught up in the crisis. A further EUR8 million is dedicated to supporting Sudan's neighbours to ...
