The uppercase letter for H name is "haitch" (/ 'heIt? /), also known as simply "aitch" (/ 'eIt? / In chemistry, H is the symbol for hydrogen. In music, H is a note in the German system, meaning "B natural". In particle physics, H is the symbol for the Higgs boson.
