About 49% of the population of Haiti had access to electricity as of 2022. In rural areas, that number is closer to 2%, and while 80% of Haiti's urban areas have access to electricity, that access may not be reliable. "Even when a household is connected to the power grid, they might only have power for three to eight hours a day."

Nearly three-quarters of Haiti's 10 million citizens lack access to reliable electricity. A primary cause is the nation's limited and unreliable power grid, which forces many small towns to seek their own solutions in order to provide power to local households, schools and the nation's growing economic sectors.

In place of a national grid, the national power utility, Electricit#233; d"Ha#239;ti (EDH), operates one primary grid serving the Port-au-Prince metropolitan area and a small number of isolated power grids for the rest of the country.
