Should you pay for solar panels in cash?

You don't have to finance the solar panels through the installation company. Your trusted local bank might offer solar loans, or you could avoid financing schemes all together and ask for a cash price, she advises. This is one of the most common ways 'fake' solar companies have targeted consumers - whereby they take a hefty deposit and then never turn up to carry out the installation. Minnesota is suing firms who finance solar power systems for homes. The case alleges that four lending companies deceived customers with hidden, upfront fees in exchange for lower interest rates.
