

What are the parameters of a battery energy storage system?

Several important parameters describe the behaviors of battery energy storage systems. Capacity[Ah]: The amount of electric charge the system can deliver to the connected load while maintaining acceptable voltage.

How does a lithium battery work?

When the battery is charging, the lithium ions flow from the cathode to the anode, and the electrons move from the anode to the cathode. As long as lithium ions are making the trek from one electrode to another, there is a constant flow of electrons. This provides the energy to keep your device running.

Not only are lithium-ion batteries widely used for consumer electronics and electric vehicles, but they also account for over 80% of the more than 190 gigawatt-hours (GWh) of battery energy storage deployed globally through 2023.

What are the degradation mechanisms of lithium ion batteries?

The most common degradation mechanisms in lithium-ion batteries include: Reduction of the organic carbonate electrolyte at the anode, which results in the growth of Solid Electrolyte Interface (SEI), where  $\text{Li}^+$  ions get irreversibly trapped, i.e. loss of lithium inventory. This shows as increased ohmic impedance and reduced Ah charge.
