How many islands are in the Northern Mariana Islands?

Northern Mariana Islands, a self-governing commonwealth in association with the United States. It is composed of 14 islands and islets in the western Pacific Ocean. The commonwealth is a part of the Mariana Islands, a chain of volcanic mountain peaks and uplifted coral reefs.

These coastal zones, particularly on the western sides of the islands, feature a combination of sandy beaches and rocky shores, shaped by the oceanic forces and coral reef structures.

How many people live in the Northern Mariana Islands?

As of the 2020 Census, except for the U.S. Minor Outlying Islands, the Northern Mariana Islands are the second least populous sub-federal jurisdiction in the United States, next to American Samoa. However, the islands population has fluctuated over time hitting 80 thousand in 2000, then declining to around 50 thousand in the 2010s.
