Which sectors use the most electricity in the Northern Mariana Islands?

The commercial sector, led by tourism, is the largest electricity-consuming sector in the Northern Mariana Islands. 53 CNMI hotels use electricity for air conditioning, water heating, water purification, and lighting.

Does CNMI have a solar power plant on Saipan?

A large 20-megawatt solar photovoltaic (PV) facility on Saipan is in the preliminary stages of development. CNMI's electric utility generates electricity at five diesel-fueled power plants (three on Saipan and one each on Tinian and Rota) and the territory's entire population has access to electricity.

Does CNMI charge a fuel surcharge?

Electricity customers in CNMI pay a fuel surcharge that varies with the price of diesel fuel. In May 2020, the fuel surcharge was at a low of 8 cents per kilowatt-hour, but it had increased to 43 cents per kilowatt-hour by July 2022. In February 2023, CNMI's fuel surcharge was about 28 cents per kilowatt-hour.

In addition to the first round of awards from the Energy Efficiency Revolving Loan Fund Capitalization Grant (RLF) Program announced earlier this month, Alaska, Ohio and the Northern Mariana Islands have crossed the finish line to receive their grant.
