

Why is re a strategic goal for the Palestinian Energy Authority?

RE resources present a strategic goal for the Palestinian Energy Authority in order to achieve some degree of economic independence. Recently, after the evolution of increasing oil prices, energy has become another major challenge to sustainable development for Palestinian .

Why is energy demand so high in Palestine?

In addition high growth of population, increasing living standards and rapid growth of industrial have led to tremendous energy demand in Palestine in recent years. The total energy consumption per habitant in Palestine is the lowest in the region (0.79 MW h/inhabitant) and costs more than anywhere else in the Middle East countries.

Does Palestine have a high solar energy potential?

By the other hand, Palestine has a high solar energy potential about 3000 sunshine hours per year with a solar radiation (kW h/m /day) for year 2013 of 8.27 in Ramallah, 7.51 in Hebron, 6.86 in Salfet and 6.15 in Tubas. These values are encouraging to exploit the solar energy for different applications.

Is Palestine a good place to invest in solar energy?

Palestine has some of the highest rate of solar water heating in the region, and there are a number of solar power projects. A number of issues confront renewable energy development; a lack of national infrastructure and the limited regulatory framework of the Oslo Accords are both barriers to investment.

Renewable energy in Palestine is a small but significant component of the national energy mix, accounting for 1.4% of energy produced in 2012. [1] Palestine has some of the highest rate of solar water heating in the region, [2] and there are a number of solar power projects.

Power generation from the plant is expected to commence at the end of 2023. [28] The power plant is expected to provide around 40% of Palestine's annual electricity needs in both the West Bank and Gaza Strip, with a total annual production capacity of around 3,700 GWh. [29]

According to the results, all of the Palestinian territories have a high potential for PV power output within 1,700 kWh/kWp, while the maximum amount of energy that can be produced in Gaza and the southernmost part of the West Bank is higher than 1,800 kWh/kWp, and the system performance ratio (PR) for fixed mode has reached 80 %.

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More incentives and fiscal mechanisms are needed to be devised in Palestine, especially for small and medium power RE systems. There is a need to develop strategies, policies, and action plans of RE utilization for heating and cooling applications, especially for residential buildings.
