What are the operational principles of thermal energy storage systems?

The operational principles of thermal energy storage systems are identical as other forms of energy storage methods, as mentioned earlier. A typical thermal energy storage system consists of three sequential processes: charging, storing, and discharging periods.

Are energy storage technologies viable for grid application?

How is thermal energy stored?
