Does Puerto Rico have power?

BAYAMÓN, Puerto Rico (AP) -- A power company in Puerto Rico announced Thursday that it has restored electricity to most areas affected by a massive outage that hit the U.S. territory the previous day. The outage left over 340,000 customers in the capital, San Juan, and neighboring municipalities without power during a heat wave.

What's going on with Luma energy in Puerto Rico?

The feud between the government-owned utility Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority and privately run grid manager LUMA Energy is drawing new attention to Puerto Rico's power struggles. Are Puerto Rico's power outages affecting the power grid?
