What plants grow in St Martin?

What is St Martin nature reserve?

The goal of St. Martin Nature Reserve is to protect the island's five main ecosystems: the coral reef, the mangroves, the phanerogam seagrass bed, ponds and the coastal forest. The different sites shelter diverse marine and terrestrial plant and animal species, and among them are several protected species.

By law, Saint-Martin's residents pay the same electricity rates as all other French citizens, with utility rates starting at \$0.12 per kilowatt-hour (kWh) for residential customers.

Castor Bean (*Ricinus communis*) plants are a common sight on St. Martin, but this plant is native to Africa and the Middle East. Castor seeds have been found in 4,000 year-old Egyptian tombs. The oil from castor seeds was used for oil lamps, machinery and medicine. Castor oil is still produced on St. Martin today.
