

Does Slovak Republic have a good energy policy?

Since 2016, the International Energy Agency's (IEA) in-depth country policy reviews focus on key energy security challenges in fast-changing global energy markets as well as on the transition to clean energy systems. The latest review of the Slovak Republic's energy policies finds the country has made significant progress on several fronts.

Is Slovak a member of the International Energy Agency?

Since May 2004, and since 2007 has been a member of the International Energy Agency (IEA). The Slovak Republic adopted the joint European currency, the euro, in January 2009. In November 2014, the Slovak Government approved an Energy Policy (EP SR).

What is the priority of the Slovak Republic in the energy sector?

The priority of the Slovak Republic in the energy sector is to ensure synergy between sub-policies, cost efficiency, enforcement of the principles of sovereignty in the energy mix, preservation of competitiveness and energy security.

Why is energy security important in the Slovak Energy Strategy?

With high dependency on energy imports, energy security is one of the priority topics of the Slovak national energy strategies. This provides a good basis for further developing the energy security dimension in the final plan, with objectives and policies and measures clearly described.

The key objectives of the Slovak energy policy agenda are: increasing efficiency in the power and end-use sectors, reducing energy intensity, reducing dependence on energy imports, expanding the use of nuclear power, increasing the share of renewables in the heat and electricity sectors, and supporting the use of alternative fuels for transport.
