Conversion factor: To convert square meters to square feet, we use the conversion factor of 1 square meter = 10.764 square feet. Let's assume an average solar irradiance of 975 kWh/m<sup>2</sup>/year and a panel efficiency of 17%: Estimated electricity generation (kWh/square foot/year) = (975 kWh/m<sup>2</sup>/year) x (0.17) x (1 m<sup>2</sup>; = 10.764 ft<sup>2</sup>);

To find the solar panel output, use the following solar power formula: output = solar panel kilowatts × environmental factor × solar hours per day . The output will be given in kWh, and, in practice, it will depend on how sunny it is since the number of solar hours per day is just an average.

Hi Deepak. You'd need approximately 20kW of solar panels to produce 100kWh of power per day. The area will depend on the exact panels used, but assuming an average-sized 290W panel (1.954m x 0.982m) is used and the panels are laid flat, approximately 6,620 square meters of area would be required.
