

Is there a solar power plant in the Ivory Coast?

The first phase of a solar power plant in the northern part of the Ivory Coast has been inaugurated. Financing for the solar power plant in Boundiali was first announced in 2018, while commissioning plans were shared in December 2022.

How many solar plants will Ivory Coast have by 2040?

Mamadou Sangafowa Coulibaly, the Ivory Coast's Minister of Mines, Oil and Energy, has announced plans to install 678 MW of solar capacity by 2030 and 1,686 MW by 2040. According to the government's website, there are plans for 12 new solar plants with a combined capacity of 628 MWp.

When will Ivory Coast's solar projects be commissioned?

Commissioning of these projects will take place in 2025 and 2026. Coulibaly said the Ivory Coast's installed solar capacity currently stands at 2,907 MW. The country is now working toward deployment targets of 3,500 MW in 2025, 5,200 MW by 2030 and 8,600 by 2040.

Ivory Coast also shows a strong potential for the development of solar energy, especially on the northern part of the country with a Solar Global Horizontal Irradiation averaging 2077 kWh/m². Solar energy in Ivory Coast is ...

In 2023, Ivory Coast had the second-highest GDP per capita in West Africa, behind Cape Verde. Despite this, as of the most recent survey in 2016, 46.1% of the population continues to be affected by multidimensional

poverty. In 2020, Ivory Coast was the world's largest exporter of cocoa beans and had high levels of income for its region.
