Is there a market for roof-top solar energy systems in Timor-Leste?

How will Jatropha impact Timor-Leste's energy sector?

To have a meaningful impact on the energy sector, the government of Timor-Leste will need to look at Jatropha programs that are capable of providing a uniform fuel type throughout the country, thus one of the programs-- B5 through B20--for biodiesel.

What is rural energy policy in Timor-Leste?

A key objective is to ensure that the implementation of the government's rural energy programs provides equitable distribution of benefits. In Timor-Leste the Secretary of State for Energy Policy is responsible for the design and implementation of the government's rural energy program.

What is Timor-Leste's energy policy?

In the context of Timor-Leste, part of the policy is promoting the use of renewable energy resources that are indigenous to rural locations and are environmentally benign. Another key part is promoting programs that replace fuel-wood with modern liquid fuels that are cleaner to handle and produce fewer harmful emissions.

Does Timor-Leste have a biogas project?

As yet, however, no operational and cost data from the biogas installations in Timor-Leste are available, so it is difficult to make a detailed quantitative assessment. Nevertheless, some estimates can be made using information collected from the team's field mission and from international benchmarks.

Does Timor-Leste have a diesel power plant?

Two power plants--the 119.5 MW Hera Diesel Power Plant and the 136.6 MW Betano Diesel Power Plant--supply all of mainland Timor-Leste's electricity needs. Both plants can run on heavy fuel oil or natural gas but need some modifications. Converting the diesel power plants to run on natural gas is possible.

The Chuditch PSC is located approximately 185km south of Timor-Leste, 100km east of the producing Bayu-Undan field, and 50km south of the Greater Sunrise potential development. It covers an area of approximately 3,571 km², in water depths of 50-100m, and contains the Chuditch-1 gas discovery drilled by Shell in 1998.
