Who owns the energy in Trinidad & Tobago?

In 1994, it divested from its generation holdings on the larger island of Trinidad and now purchases energy from three Independent Power Producers (IPPs): the Power Generation Company of Trinidad and Tobago, which purchased the former T&TEC-operated plants and presently controls 1,386 megawatts (MW) of gas-fired capacity across

Does Trinidad and Tobago have fossil fuel resources?

Trinidad and Tobago has abundant local fossil fuel resources, but is taking steps to prepare the societal, legal, regulatory, and economic foundations necessary to support renewable energy and energy efficiency technologies.

How much does electricity cost in Trinidad & Tobago?

Trinidad and Tobago's electricity rates are some of the lowest in the Caribbean at approximately \$0.04 per kilowatt-hour (kWh), well below the regional average of \$0.33/kWh. Unlike many island nations, Trinidad and Tobago has significant oil and natural gas reserves and is a net exporter of these fuels.

Is biomass a source of electricity in Trinidad & Tobago?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. Trinidad and Tobago: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power? Nuclear power - alongside renewables - is a low-carbon source of electricity.

Does Trinidad & Tobago need energy subsidies?

Unlike many island nations, Trinidad and Tobago has significant oil and natural gas reserves and is a net exporter of these fuels. However, subsidies for domestic energy consumption have created a fiscal burden on the government that could be reduced through the expansion of alternative transportation fuels, energy efficiency, and renewable energy.

Energy Snapshot Trinidad and Tobago This profile provides a snapshot of the energy landscape of Trinidad and Tobago, a two-island nation located off the coast of Venezuela. Trinidad and Tobago's electricity rates are some of the lowest in the Caribbean at approximately \$0.04 per kilowatt-hour (kWh), well below the regional

average of \$0.33/kWh.

The company continues to explore deepwater concessions in Trinidad and Tobago, with stakes in blocks 23A and TTDA 14. The nation is aiming to increase gas production to feed its high liquefaction capacity. Trinidad and Tobago currently has the capacity to produce 119 mcm (4.2 bcf) of gas into LNG.

With a target of 30% of electricity from renewable sources by 2030, Trinidad and Tobago has placed a focus on solar PV and wind (offshore and onshore) energy electricity generation. Trinidad and Tobago has favourable solar irradiation levels and being an island there is particular interest in offshore wind energy technology deployment.
