



# Tuvalu solar city project

What is the Tuvalu solar power project?

The Government of Tuvalu worked with the e8 group to develop the Tuvalu Solar Power Project, which is a 40 kW grid-connected solar system that is intended to provide about 5% of Funafuti's peak demand, and 3% of the Tuvalu Electricity Corporation's annual household consumption.

What was the first large scale solar system in Tuvalu?

The first large scale system in Tuvalu was a 40 kW solar panel installation on the roof of Tuvalu Sports Ground. This grid-connected 40 kW solar system was established in 2008 by the E8 and Japan Government through Kansai Electric Company (Japan) and contributes 1% of electricity production on Funafuti.

Where does Tuvalu electricity come from?

Tuvalu's power has come from electricity generation facilities that use imported diesel brought in by ships. The Tuvalu Electricity Corporation (TEC) on the main island of Funafuti operates the large power station (2000 kW).

The Increasing Access to Renewable Energy Project will reduce diesel generation and increase the renewable energy contribution from 15 per cent to 32 per cent in Funafuti and from around 70 per cent to over 90 per cent in Tuvalu's outer islands. "The project is the first ADB-supported energy sector project in Tuvalu," said the director of ...

In September 2014, Infratec and Solar City were awarded the contract to build a 170kW solar array on two rooftops in Funafu, Tuvalu for NZ Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The project also involved painting the rooftop of the three-storey Government Building prior to installing the solar array on the roof.

project in Tuvalu is a prime example of the program's work in supporting the SIDS countries' transformation of their energy sectors to address climate change. As of October 2020, 60 percent of the equipment to build the solar installation (solar PVs, battery, pre-payment meters, and high frequency radio) has been delivered and stored.
