Is ABB building a wind farm in Western Sahara?

Swedish-Swiss company ABB was selected to build the first hybrid substation for a wind farm in Western Sahara. The company declared on 7 July 2017 its operation, but without specifying its location. Find the original press release here. The work relates to the construction of Morocco's so-called Aftissat wind farm.

How many wind farms are in occupied Western Sahara?

Two of these farms, of a combined 400 MW, will be in occupied Western Sahara: the 300MW Boujdour wind farm and the 100 MW Tiskrad Wind Farm. The Tiskrad Wind Farm is still in permitting stage. The Boujdour farm was completed in July 2023. To implement the Boujdour wind farm, NEGPM created a joint venture with ONEE.

Is the environmental impact assessment addressing legal issues in Western Sahara?

It was also clear in September 2023 that the Environmental Impact Assessment - which claims to be addressing legal aspects, totally ignores that the operation is in Western Sahara at all, and speaking uncritically about the future arrival of new immigrants - obviously from Morocco - as consequence of the project.

Is Kosmos drilling in Western Sahara?

Kosmos in 2014-2015 undertook the first ever oil drilling in Western Sahara waters since the occupation of the territory in 1975. Western Sahara Resource Watch in 2014 wrote a report about Kosmos Energy's upcoming drilling operation.

The project generates 420GWh electricity and supplies enough clean energy to power 131,000 households, offsetting 383,000t of carbon dioxide emissions (CO₂) a year. The project cost is \$228.97m. The Tubular Steel towers installed at the project site are 91m high.

At that time, the deadline had been postponed 6 times this year, as reported by Western Sahara Resource Watch (WSRW). The project entails a 1,400 km-long transmission line that will connect Dakhla, located along the mid-coast of occupied Western Sahara, to Casablanca, Morocco's largest city and its economic and business centre.

As such, the projects fundamentally undermine the UN peace efforts in Western Sahara directed towards

allowing the expression of the right to self-determination of the Saharawi people. The energy is used by industries that plunder the territory's non-renewable resources, and provides job opportunities attracting more settlers from Morocco.
