The combination of multiple photovoltaic modules (or panels) is called a photovoltaic system. Solar panels produce direct current (DC) but with a solar inverter, you can convert it to alternate current (AC), which is used for home appliances. Solar panels are divided into photovoltaic cells, and most models have 60 or 72, in a 6#215;10 or 6#215;12 distribution. Some of the latest solar panels have a half-cell design that improves their efficiency, and they have 120 or 144. However, the solar panel size does not increase because each PV cell is only half as large.

A solar panel system typically generates double its "size". For example, a standard "4 kilowatt peak" (kWp) solar panel system could generate around 8kWh of electricity in a day (weather-dependent).
