The size of a solar battery is measured in kWh instead of kW, because they store energy rather than creating it. And as mentioned above, the average three-bedroom household with a 3.5kWp solar panel system should usually look for a 5-6kWh solar battery.

By converting electrical energy into chemical energy, batteries offer a reliable way to store solar energy for use when needed--whether during the night or during a power outage. In solar batteries, when electricity is generated by your solar panels, it is stored in the form of chemical energy inside the battery.

DC, or direct current, is what batteries use to store energy and how PV panels generate electricity. AC, or alternating current, is what the grid and appliances use. A DC-coupled system needs a bidirectional inverter to connect battery storage directly to the PV array, while an AC-coupled system needs a bidirectional inverter and a PV inverter.

Under typical UK conditions, 1m² of PV panel will produce around 100kWh electricity per year, so it would take around 2.5 years to "pay back" the energy cost of the panel. PV panels have an expected life of least 25 to 30 years, so even under UK conditions a PV panel will generate many times more energy than was needed to manufacture it.

Figure 1 shows PV generation in watts for a solar PV system on 11 July 2020, when it was sunny throughout the day and on 13 July when there was a mixture of sun and cloud.
