Upon completion, the solar power plant in Kabulasoke, Mubende, funded by the Uganda Development Bank (UDB), will generate 20 MW. Dr. David Aloba, Founder and Managing Director of Xsabo Group, asserts that the plant is Sub-Saharan Africa's most modern and the largest in East and Central Africa.

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RIC Energy is building the project, named Nkonge, for The Xsabo Group, a Kampala-based German-Ugandan diversified consultancy. Works will also include the construction of a 132-kV/33-kV step-up substation and a 4.5-kilometre 132-kV overhead line, RIC Energy said. The Spanish firm expects to wrap up construction some time in the first half of 2023.
